## Membership Welcome Packet

### NCC Rules & Policies

Welcome to Nevada Country Club! We are happy to have you! This packet is to help familiarize you with the Club and all it has to offer.

First and foremost, you will receive a **membership number**. This number indicates your membership at the Club, and will be used in various matters, such as when ordering food from the restaurant. This number indicates Full Resident Members (1-2999) Social Members (3000-3999), or other Membership types (4000+).

Your dues/charges will be paid in a monthly bill. We will be rolling out an online invoicing and payment system, or you can still choose to have a traditional invoice mailed each month.

Our Membership Committee may ask for a family photo/profile to welcome you and your family to the Club on our social media pages. Currently, we have a website, [nevadacountryclub.net](http://nevadacountryclub.net), a private and public Facebook page, and an Instagram page (Nevada Country Club, Nevada Country Club Members).

**Full Resident** members and their family unit (up to age 25) are welcome to use all facilities of the Club: Golf Course, Pool, Tennis Courts, Clubhouse, etc.

**Social Members** and their family unit (up to age 25) are welcome to use the same facilities, except the Golf Course.

**Non-Resident** members and their family unit (up to age 25) are welcome to use all facilities of the Club: Golf Course, Pool, Tennis Courts, Clubhouse, etc.; Must primarily live outside of Vernon County to be eligible for Non-Resident Membership.

**Stock Ownership**

Full Resident members are eligible to purchase stock. Stock Certificates provide ownership equity in the Nevada Country Club. This allows the member to become a voting shareholder and eligible to serve on the Board of Directors. Stock is non-transferable and must be surrendered if Members resign their membership, are expelled, or drop to Social Membership. **Members who elect to resign their membership will be ineligible to re-apply for membership for 2 years without a waiver from the Board of Directors, which may or may not be granted.**

## **Guest Policies:**

The Club welcomes Members to bring Guests to our facilities. The Member is responsible for any Guests brought under their name, financially and otherwise. Members may bring Guests to dine in the clubhouse. **Vernon County-resident** Guests may come to the Club for **ONE Golf or Swim outing per year**, excluding Club-Sponsored Tournaments, Facility Rentals, and Special Events. **Out-of-county residents** may be brought as Guests on multiple occasions, provided they are hosted by a Member and pay the requisite Greens Fee/Pool Fee and are signed in at the Clubhouse.

While there are no restrictions on bringing Guests to eat in the clubhouse, we **STRONGLY ENCOURAGE** Members to recruit frequent guests to consider joining the Club with a membership. We want a vibrant community to share in the fellowship that the Nevada Country Club provides. However, it is difficult to promote that vision if frequent guests enjoy the amenities of membership without personal investment into the Club.

Green Fees will be \$20/round, and Cart Rental Fee will be \$10/round (excluding Club-sponsored Tournaments). Serious Prospective Members *may* be allowed a 2nd outing after expressing legitimate interest to a member of the Board. Members may bring guests for use of the pool for a Guest Pass Fee (\$5 per guest, \$3 for under 3 years of age). A pass for additional out of town family members (ie. Grandkids) may be purchased for \$20/week/guest. ALL GUESTS MUST BE SIGNED IN AND LOGGED WITH MEMBER on designated book.

**Guest Policy Violations:** While we enjoy having guests at the Club, we do not want our facilities to be taken advantage of without proper investment. To ensure adherence to Guest Policies, the following actions may be taken if Guest Policy is violated.

1st violation - Member hosting guest will be charged greens fee/pool fee and reminded verbally that said guest has already used their yearly visit to the club.

2nd violation - Golf/Pool Fee charged to Member, and Member will be sent a letter from the Board of Directors detailing the violation.

3rd violation - Golf/Pool Fee charged to member; Member to be brought in before the Board of Directors for potential disciplinary action; which may include, but is not limited to: fines, suspension, or expulsion.

## **Facilities & Activities:**

**The Clubhouse** hours vary by day and season. Upstairs is a dining area that is more upscale in terms of experience and food/beverage selection. Downstairs, the Pro Shop is more grab-n-go style food, hamburgers/fries, etc. When ordering, give the waiter/waitress your membership number, and the order will be added to your monthly bill, or can be paid on site with a credit card. Reservations are encouraged. Call 417-667-7182. NO CASH.

The Clubhouse may be rented for events. See the Clubhouse Manager for details.

**The Pool** will be open from approximately Memorial Day thru Labor Day; weather and circumstances permitting. The pool may have an attendant on duty, but it is still the responsibility of the Member to watch their children or guests. The Pro Shop will have a guest sign-in book to indicate the activity and Member responsible for that guest. Space at The Pool may be rented for parties. See the Clubhouse Manager for details.

**Tennis Courts** are open year-round. Members bringing Guests to play should log them in at the Pro Shop. We hope to develop activities and tournaments for this space as well.

**Golf** - Resident Members are welcome to use the Golf Course, and host **Guests for a round once a year** as well. The Club hosts three annual tournaments each year; The Invitational, Member-Guest, and Ullmann Classic. Outside of these tournament weekends, and 54 Cup weekend, the course is open for members and does not require a tee time. However, there are some Club sponsored activities that take priority on the Course. These include Mens' League (Jackpot), and if formed, Couples' League, and Ladies' League.

Parents of children who are using carts on the course are responsible for their behavior. We are working on rules and regulations for making sure our golf course is respected by all members and families.

There are cart sheds available to rent. Contact the Golf Grounds Committee if you would like one assigned to you.

The Club has a limited supply of golf carts (2) available for rent for a round. They are stored in cart sheds near the clubhouse. The lock code will be posted in the Pro Shop and may change month to month..

If Resident Members want to host Guests for a round, they must sign in in the Pro Shop. There will be a sign in sheet to log-in and pay greens and cart fees for guests.

**Pro Shop** - This is the main day-to-day area for guest sign-ins, meeting place, etc. It is the location of the Downstairs restaurant, as well as the location for Golf scorecards, etc. The Pro Shop has Merchandise for sale, which we hope to grow our selection in coming years. Members wishing to purchase items make a ticket/record the sale, and it will be added to your monthly bill.

## **Special Events:**

**54 Cup:** The 54 Cup is an annual competition held in September between Nevada Country Club and the El Dorado Springs Golf Course. The top 14 golfers will be invited to compete for the NCC for a traveling trophy.

### **2024 54 Cup Qualifying Information & Rules**

- El Dorado Springs will be hosting the event on September 14-15th
- The matches will again be AM & PM team events on Saturday & singles on Sunday.
- The qualifying dates are listed at the bottom of the page.
- Like the last several years there is a 5 round minimum and we will count up to the last 13 rounds played. The best round and the worst 3 are emitted.\* (more info below)
- If in the last 2-3 weeks you still need a couple of rounds but can't make a scheduled time, contact a committee member, and if possible, they will try and find a time to play a round with you.
- To be eligible to qualify for the team you must either be a member of NCC or have been on the team in the past.
- We need to know if you are planning on trying to qualify by August 2nd (No new qualifiers will be accepted after that date.)
- If you have any questions or thoughts now is the time to ask or give them. Please don't come up to us on September 1st complaining about the qualifying system. We are in no way trying to exclude/include anyone. We do our best to come up with a fair system that gives us the best 14 players for our team.
- All qualifying rounds must be played within the match of the "normal big group" or with a CM, with zero exceptions. You can't go out after the round with your buddies and play another 18 and send us a score and try to count it etc...

\*We will do our best to provide weekly standing updates.

*The Invitational:* 3rd Weekend in June. A 2-man tournament, typically shamble on Saturday, and either shamble or best ball on Sunday. Results are flighted out, so prizes are distributed throughout skill levels. On Friday night, before the tournament, there is a HORSE RACE. The “Horses” are ten 2-man teams, who participate in an alternate shot competition, with the worst scoring team eliminated on each hole. Spectators are heavily encouraged to watch, and to cheer on their “horse” in the few hours before the event. Typically a band or other entertainment event is held Friday or Saturday night for all members and guests, regardless if they are golfing.

*Member Guest:* 2nd Weekend in July. A Member-Guest Tournament, usually a scramble Saturday, shamble/best ball Sunday. On Friday night, before the tournament, there is a HORSE RACE. The “Horses” are ten 2-man teams, who participate in an alternate shot competition, with the worst scoring team eliminated on each hole. Spectators are heavily encouraged to watch, and to cheer on their “horse” in the few hours before the event. Typically a band or other entertainment event is held Friday or Saturday night for all members and guests, golfing or not.

*Ullmann Classic:* 1st Weekend in August, 2-Man tournament - typically Shamble Saturday, Shamble/BestBall Sunday. At the conclusion of Saturday's competition, a CALCUTTA auction is held that evening. Players and spectators may “buy” teams, putting confidence on their Sunday performance. Typically a band or other entertainment event is held Friday or Saturday night for all members, golfing or not.

*Men's League - “Jackpot”* - Wednesday Evenings starting at 5:30pm. Mid-April thru Mid-September. Players gather in the Pro Shop around 5:15pm and pay \$5-10 per man. ALL SKILL LEVELS ARE WELCOME. Once everyone is gathered, players are split by skill level into three pots: “A, B, or C”. **A** players are typically 10-ish handicap and below, **B** players are 10-20ish handicap, and **C**'s are 20+. It is very low pressure, and lots of fun. Names are drawn into 3 or 4 man scramble teams, then go out and play. It is a low-stress, fun-filled night of fellowship and enjoying each other's company on the golf course.

*Couples League* - Working on restarting Couples League for our lovely couples!

*Ladies Tournaments* - Have not been held the past few years, but would love for some new members to help revive these! **June:** Ladies Open 2-Woman Scramble. **July:** Ladies Shamble Member-Guest. **August:** Ladies Fun Day.

Bunco Night - A popular event with the ladies, Bunco Night has become a significant event at the club. Bunco Night often has fun prizes, great games, and plenty of excitement.

## **More Information:**

Unofficial Golf (men) - "Tuesday Group" - Most Saturdays (mid morning start), Sundays (noon start), and Tuesdays (3-4pm start). Play 18 holes in a semi-competitive setting. Teams are divided for a "Big Match" in which a best ball format Nassau is played (Don't worry if you don't know what it means, its pretty easy to learn). There are also side games played (Captains, Birdie Game, Skins). Typically meet in the Pro Shop or under the big tree on #9 fairway. Shooting your own ball- Score at 95 (using a double bogey max on each hole) or below consistently is recommended. Serves as the qualifying group for 54 Cup qualification.

Bridge Group - Group that meets weekly to play Bridge.
